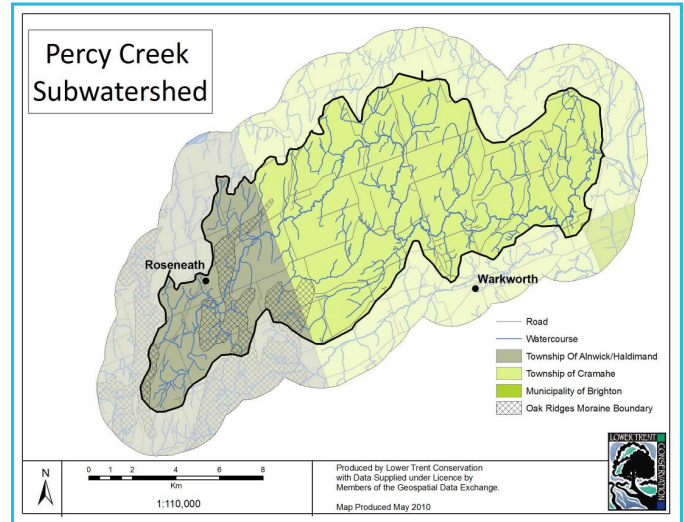

## Percy Creek

Percy Creek originates on the eastern side of the Oak Ridges Moraine and flows east towards the Trent River. It supports a predominantly coldwater fishery and several Species at Risk such as the Blanding's Turtle and the Eastern Hog-nosed Snake. Percy Creek also has Significant Natural Areas such as the Northumberland County Forest and the Alderville Woods.

Percy Creek is 148 km<sup>2</sup> and covers portions of the Township of Alnwick/Haldimand, the Municipality of Trent Hills, and a small portion of the Municipality of Brighton.
